GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

These are the criteria that apply for all scholarships

- Applicant is a member of the graduating class of 2026 OR actively transferring from a Community College (transfer students are not eligible if they have previously applied and been granted an IAF scholarship). Applicant is seeking to further their education by attending a 2- or 4-year college, trade or vocational school, or military academy
- Applicant is of Italian Descent
- Completed applications submitted by the applicant must include:
 - This Scholarship Application with all sections completed (pages 2 thru 4).
 - Official Signed Transcript of applicant's scholastic record including 1st semester of senior year. Transfer students must include Official Signed Community College transcript including at least one semester and/or two quarters.
 - Two Letters of Recommendation, one must be from a current faculty/staff member of the school you are attending and one personal letter of recommendation speaking to your character (letters may be sent separately, however receipt is required for scholarship consideration).

All documents must be received by 11:59 pm on **Friday, March 27th** via email with all supporting documents (transcripts and letters of recommendation).

Scholarship recipients will be notified by email by **May 2nd**, with results from the Scholarship Committee.
